The new separate waste collection service is starting

## METHODS OF WASTE DELIVERY

### • Computerized bins of urban waste

The users in the areas served with computerized bins, will have to throw the waste at the computerized island nearest home. The opening of the bins will be through the electronic card that will be supplied with the bags. It will be possible to throw on any day and time of the week.



1 PRESS THE BUTTON

2 PLACE THE ELECTRONIC CARD NEAR THE DISPLAY



3. wait for the unlock of the drawer and proceed with:

- press the pedal or open the drawer with the handle;
- throw the waste;
- ensure that the drawer closes.

### • Proximity bins

The users in the areas served by proximity bins must go to the location nearest home, open the lock of the bins with the key supplied and throw the waste properly differentiated. It will be possible to deliver on any day and time of the week.

### • Door to door collection service

The users included in this type of service will be equipped with special bags and small bins with handle and lid. Give the properly differentiated waste into such equipment on the roadside nearby your home as follows:

#### PAPER AND CARDBOARD:

put the paper and cardboard in the **blue** bucket supplied and give it to the established days; if you must throw cardboard boxes, fold them up so that they occupy little space and insert them into a single box.



#### PLASTIC PACKAGING:

put in the **yellow** bags provided for plastic collection and give them to the established days.



#### BIO-WASTE:

use the compostable bags supplied with the aerated under-sink bucket. When full, put in the brown bin and give it to the established days.



#### GLASS:

for the glass will not be provided the door-to-door service; it must be thrown in the **green** bins for glass positioned on the street.



**NON RECYCLABLE WASTE - DRY RESIDUE:** put it in the **grey** bags provided for the collection of non recyclable waste, give it to the established days.

If you live in a block of flats with condominium bins, these will have a mechanical lock with a key for the exclusive use of your block of flats.

## INFORMATIONS ON WASTE DIFFERENTIATION

### • BIO WASTE

Organic waste consists mainly of food scraps and kitchen waste, as well as other easily biodegradable waste such as toothpicks and paper towels.

The most effective and environmentally sustainable way to manage organic waste is through **composting**. If you have a garden or a green area, it is a good idea to self-dispose of the organic waste produced at home, either by using convenient composting bins or by creating a classic compost heap.

**WHAT TO PUT:** Fruit and vegetable scraps, shells, peelings, stale bread, leftover food, small bones, mussel shells, coffee grounds, tea bags, "Ma-ter-Bi" shopping bags, paper napkins, and in small quantities ash and pruning waste of pot plants.

**WHAT DO NOT PUT:** Non-biodegradable waste, liquid food, packaged food, nappies and pet beddings, oils, cigarette butts, inked, coated or plasticized paper, Hoover bags, textiles, coffee capsules (if not biodegradable).



## • PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Paper and cardboard include all materials, made exclusively of cellulose, whether packaging or everyday items such as magazines or printed sheets of paper. What must not be included are so-called multi-packed materials, which consist of several types of material, e.g. paper-plastic or paper-aluminium. The only exception is Tetra Pak® packaging, which must be thrown with the paper since the destination plants are equipped to correctly separate the materials of which they are composed. All beverage cartons are Tetra Pak® packages and must therefore be thrown with paper.



**WHAT TO PUT:** paper and cardboard packaging, cardboard boxes, newspapers, magazines, brochures, notebooks, books, cleaned pizza boxes, printed and unprinted sheets of paper, cardboard boxes, paper bags and paper shopping bags, corrugated cardboard, milk and other beverage cartons (Tetra Pak®).

**WHAT DO NOT PUT:** receipts and other types of chemical paper, baking paper, copying paper, wallpaper, plasticized.

## • PLASTIC AND METAL PACKAGING

Only plastic or metal packaging is included in this category. All other types of non-packaging objects, even if they are made of plastic or metal, do not fall into this category and must be thrown to the non-recyclable waste or, if they are of medium or large size, taken to the collection centre (ecological island). Packagings consist of all those items we have purchased because they were containing a product. All other items that we buy directly, without any content, do not fall into the category of packaging.



**WHAT TO PUT:** bottles, flacons, fruit nets, and any other food packaging marked PE, PET, PP, PS. Styrofoam trays and packaging, rinsed disposable plastic plates and cups, plastic bags, aluminium or tin cans and jars, aluminium foil, yoghurt pots, plastic or metal caps, spray deodorant cans, Hairspray or cream spray cans, etc. o metallo, bombolette deodoranti, lacche, panna ecc.

**WHAT DO NOT PUT:** plastic toys, household appliances, Tetra Pak® packaging, CDs/DVDs/VHSs, plastic cutlery, PVC tubes and corrugated tubes, watering cans, buckets, plastic kitchen utensils, glue/solvent/paint cans, pens and markers, gloves and other rubber materials, pots and pans, toothbrushes, lighters, backpacks and generally all plastic or metal objects which are not packaging.

## • GLASS

Among glass must be thrown glass bottles and jars containing or suitable to contain food or other non-hazardous or toxic products and liquids. Ceramic objects must be absolutely avoided, because even if they are present in very small quantities, they risk nullifying the glass melting and recycling process.



**WHAT TO PUT:** bottles, jars, flacons and glass pots, glass shards.

**WHAT DO NOT PUT:** light bulbs, neon, ceramic plates and cups, crystal glasses, Pyrex glass dishes, door and window glass, mirrors, large glass panes, Glass-Block, dithered glass, windscreens, chandeliers, TV and PC screens.

## • NON RECYCLABLE WASTE-DRY RESIDUE

all materials remaining after correctly separated collection and which are therefore not recyclable should be thrown with the non-recyclable waste.

**WHAT TO PUT:** rubber gloves, grease proof paper, Hoover bags and filters, nappies and sanitary towels, CDs/DVDs/VHSs, pens and markers, hair and furs, toothbrushes, cotton buds, rags, gauzes and bandages, receipts, thermal receipt printer paper, small non-electronic toys, lighters, nylon stockings, plasticised paper, light bulbs (except neon), cigarette butts, adhesive tapes, abrasive sponges, glue tubes, rags, sponges.

**WHAT DO NOT PUT:** separable waste, batteries, medicines, toners, hazardous waste, bulky waste, electronic waste, building waste and rubble, neon bulbs, spray cans, liquids, cans of paint.
